We have established a new partnership with Lee River, an education program of Mount Mansfield Union High School. Students from Lee River spend approximately 2 hours per day, up to three days per week volunteering at the VYCC. They earn academic credit, learn job skills, and perform office, construction and maintenance related tasks. The program is coordinated by AmeriCorps VISTA volunteer Andrew Magee, who is also working with Lamoille Union High School, Montpelier High School, and U32 to develop other meaningful partnerships and expand our ability to provide year-round educational opportunities to Vermont's youth!
