Job Summary

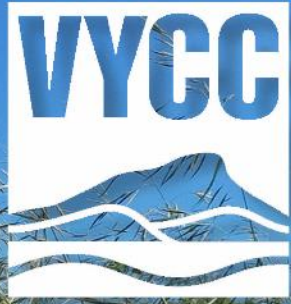

Preferred Qualifications

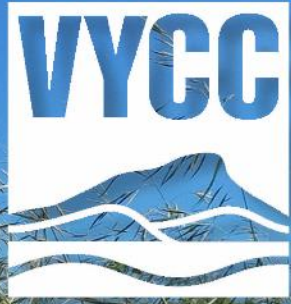
- Communicate clearly and effectively

Work Environment

Crew Members spend most of their time outdoors, working with a team while also interacting with project sponsors, community members, and VYCC staff. Camping Crew Member positions require living in a camp setting, while Day Crew Member positions do not require camping.

Compensation & Benefits

- \$250 – 310/week stipend; service bonus of \$150 – 200 awarded at end of each session; returner bonus of \$150
- Crew Members on Camping Crews receive camping accommodations, including a budget for all meals
- Farm Crews receive a weekly vegetable farm share
- Educational learning opportunities with professionals in the field of conservation and agriculture as well as professional development and personal growth
- College and career pathways support VYCC's Alumni Services
- Access to our robust Alumni network
