

CONSERVATION CAMPING CREW GEAR LIST

This document describes equipment that the VYCC provides and outlines necessary and recommended items. Upon arrival, you will be issued:

- one 1-liter water bottle
- one camp travel mug
- one medium sized plastic food container
- two VYCC uniform work shirts

- one hard hat
- one a pair of safety glasses
- hearing protection
- one pair of leather and nitrile-dipped work gloves

All of your clothing, gear, and supplies should fit into your large backpack and daypack.

There is limited use of cell phones on crews. Music players and other electronic devices are <u>prohibited</u> on crews and should not be brought.

VYCC does have items to lend on a first come, first serve basis.

VYCC issues a solo tent to each Corps Member

Necessary Equipment:

- □ **Boots:** ALL LEATHER, sturdy work or hiking style
 - Entire boot except laces and sole must be leather
 - Must fully and firmly cover the foot to and around the anklebone
 - Must be in good condition without splits, holes or tears
 - If you are unable to get boots, please contact us immediately
- ☐ **Sleeping bag:** synthetic shell with synthetic or down fill, no cotton bags
- ☐ Sleeping pad: closed cell-foam or air
- ☐ **Sturdy rain jacket & pants:** *no ponchos (it will get dirty)*
- ☐ Headlamp with extra batteries
- ☐ **Wristwatch with alarm function:** a cell phone is <u>NOT</u> acceptable for this use
- □ Water bottles: durable and able to hold at least 3 liters of water total (*Leaders: 4-5 liters*)
- □ **Daypack:** to hold all daily personal gear (water, lunch, rain gear, extra layers, WoRD Book, etc.)

(Leaders: allow for additional space for extra crew gear, ~30-40 liters)

- □ **2-3 large plastic trash bags:** to keep things dry inside your pack
- ☐ **Backpacking Pack:** (see picture right) rigid external frame or internal frame, at least 60 L
- ☐ **Toiletries kit:** toothbrush, toothpaste, biodegradable soap/shampoo, feminine hygiene products, etc.
